Eligibility for Services

The Accessibility and Disability Center (ADC) serves qualified and enrolled students with disabilities to ensure equal access to Utah Tech programs and services. A qualified student with a disability is a student with a disability who meets the academic and technical standards required for admission or participation in Utah Tech educational programs and services. As defined in the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), a person has a disability if they:

- Have a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities, **or**
- Have a record of such impairment, **or**
- Are regarded as having such impairment.

Application Process

In order to establish eligibility and to receive accommodative services, a student must do the following:

1. Self-identify as a person with a disability.
2. Complete and submit the application with appropriate documentation (https://utahtech.edu/wp-content/uploads/2025/09/adc_doc.pdf).

3. Meet with ADC staff to discuss accommodation options and the implementation process.
